

Technical Case Study - IT Centralization and consolidation

Need

The Cambridge Group, a quickly expanding group of fitness clubs, needed to link all health centers and gyms onto one centralized system. Unfortunately, all the health centers were scattered throughout the GTA and all ran different in-house applications.

Solution

D-Tech Consulting recommended a Windows 2000 Active Directory and WAN setup. Each location received new servers and workstations. A site to site VPN connection linked all offices together on one large network. Centralized Antivirus, Backup and Fault Tolerance were also put in place.

Result

The Cambridge Group was able to centralize departments and technology. All offices linked together, all computers and servers were linked to the head office server farm, anti virus and data backup were managed centrally.

Benefits

The infrastructure put into place reduced expenses for salaries and increased efficiency, saving hundreds of thousands of dollars. IT administration and Accounting administration is now centralized at head office in downtown Toronto.
